A Donation to Plant Trees

Individuals, families or organizations wishing to donate towards the planting of a larger tree on pre-approved private or public property may arrange for the planting of a Legacy Tree through Keep Nassau Beautiful. Donors contributing \$100 or more to the Legacy Tree project may choose to receive public recognition or make their donation privately.

Tax-deductible donations cover the cost of the tree, gator bag, mulch, delivery and installation. 100% of donations to this project are earmarked to support the planting of trees on pre-approved public property or common property of HOA's, businesses, or civic organizations in Nassau County.

With a minimum donation of \$300, you may donate to fund the planting of specific trees and woody species. Contact us to learn more.

A watering and maintenance plan must be available to help establish the tree to the location. Tree planting location, species and watering schedule must be approved by the property owner.
